- 1. Must be actively involved in the promotion of multicultural literacy
- 2. Be a resident of the state of Georgia
- 3. Must submit the completed cover sheet and award application

Submit the following information on the nominee:

- 1. Biographical information
 - a. Full name
 - b. Current job and title
 - c. Number of years associated with literacy education
 - d. GALA/GRA and Local Council Total Years of Membership and Leadership Positions Held
- 2. Statement of how nominee is directly involved in the promotion of multicultural literacy. We request that scrapbooks and newspaper articles not be submitted.
 - a. Typed, narrative statement of examples of multicultural literacy activities and events in which the nominee participated. Include a description of the way the nominee promoted diversity and inclusion, clearly indicating the targeted audience, age of audience, dates, locations, names of the events and activities, and any pertinent, supporting documentation. Note the use of multicultural literature in instruction, if applicable. The events and activities can be related to education in the classroom, adult education, hobbies, civic or volunteer work, and/or church or community programs that promoted cultural diversity in literacy.
 - b. Typed, narrative statement of examples of multicultural literacy activities and events that promoted diversity and inclusion that the nominee created and/or participated in at the planning level. Include a description of the targeted audience, age of the audience, dates, location, names of the events and activities, and any pertinent, supporting documentation. Note the use of multicultural literature or authoring multicultural literature, if applicable. The events and activities can be related to education in the classroom, adult education, hobbies, civic or volunteer work, and/or church or community programs that promoted cultural diversity in literacy.

- 3. Two Letters of Recommendation from two colleagues or persons in leadership or supervision to support the nomination of this person as deserving to receive this honor. One of the letters may be written by the person making the nomination.
- 4. A copy of one item of documentation to indicate the nominee was involved in the promotion of multicultural literacy as indicated in a brochure, a program, a letter, an award, a newspaper or other published article, a photograph, or other means of documentation.
